3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. To promote, support, and undertake all types of educational, literacy, and learning activities, including the establishment, management, operation, and maintenance of schools, colleges, training centers, coaching institutes, libraries, vocational and skill development centers, e-learning platforms, and other institutions for imparting formal and non-formal education at all levels.
2. To organize and conduct educational programs, workshops, seminars, awareness campaigns, and scholarship initiatives aimed at the upliftment of economically weaker sections, marginalized groups, women, and children to promote inclusive and equitable quality education for all.
3. To collaborate with government bodies, NGOs, corporate entities, academic institutions, and international organizations for the implementation of education, literacy, digital learning, and social development projects.
4. To promote vocational training, career counseling, digital literacy, entrepreneurship development, and employment-oriented education, thereby

empowering youth, women, and underprivileged individuals to become self-reliant and skilled contributors to society.

5. To undertake and promote research, innovation, and capacity-building programs in the fields of education, social sciences, sustainable development, and community welfare.

6. To work towards the upliftment, welfare, and empowerment of underprivileged, marginalized, and needy sections of society irrespective of caste, creed, religion, gender, or social status, through various social, educational, medical, and cultural initiatives.

7. To organize and support healthcare, sanitation, nutrition, environment, and community development programs in coordination with educational and social initiatives for the overall improvement of living standards.

8. To establish and run orphanages, old age homes, child welfare centers, rehabilitation centers, and shelters for destitute persons, and to provide them with education, training, and livelihood opportunities

9. To receive grants, donations, subscriptions, contributions, and funds from any lawful source, including individuals, trusts, societies, companies, or government bodies, and to utilize the same solely for the promotion of the aforesaid objects

10. To carry out all such activities as may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above main objects and to work for the overall betterment of society through education, social welfare, and humanitarian service.

11. To establish, promote, operate and manage medical colleges, nursing colleges, paramedical institutes, community health centres and

allied medical education institutions for the purpose of advancing medical education, research, healthcare training and community health services for the general public, especially marginalized communities.

12. To work towards the prevention, control, treatment and rehabilitation of persons affected by leprosy, including the establishment of leprosy care centres, awareness programs, medical camps, community-based rehabilitation, and support to families affected by leprosy.

13. To promote the welfare, empowerment and social inclusion of transgender persons by providing education, counselling, healthcare access, livelihood support, legal awareness, skill development, employment opportunities and capacity-building programmes.

14. To establish, manage and support skill development centres, vocational training institutes, and job-oriented training programmes in various fields including computer education, information technology, engineering skills, electrical and mechanical trades, entrepreneurship, and other employability-enhancing courses for youth, women, transgender persons, and disadvantaged groups.

15. To provide training, workshops, career counselling, incubation support and employment-linked programmes for the overall development of socially and economically weaker sections, including rural and urban poor.

16. To collaborate with government agencies, educational institutions, hospitals, research bodies, NGOs and CSR-funded programs for improving healthcare delivery, medical research, community development, and inclusive social welfare activities.

17. To undertake research, development, awareness drives and outreach programs in areas of public health, hygiene, sanitation, communicable diseases, mental health, disability inclusion, women's health and social welfare.

18. To provide scholarships, financial support, stipends, learning materials and mentorship programs for students from underprivileged categories pursuing medical, technical, vocational or general education.

ANCILLARY / INCIDENTAL OBJECTS:

19. To publish, print, produce, and distribute educational materials, journals, books, magazines, reports, and digital content for promoting education and social awareness.

20. To enter into partnerships or collaborations with institutions or individuals having similar objectives.

21. To acquire, lease, or construct land, buildings, or premises for carrying out educational and social activities.

22. To employ qualified teachers, trainers, counselors, doctors, and social workers as necessary for fulfilling the company's objectives.

OTHER OBJECTS:

23. To collaborate with educational institutions, non-governmental organizations, and corporate social responsibility (CSR) initiatives for inclusive and knowledge-driven development.

24. To do all such other lawful things as may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.
